- E. Project Description: Project consists of the removal of the existing dust collector equipment and installation of a new dust collector to serve the wood shop at the High School. Work includes modifications to the existing roof over the dust collector including minor structural steel modifications and minor masonry repairs. The limited mechanical and electrical connections are included as part of the General Construction contract.
